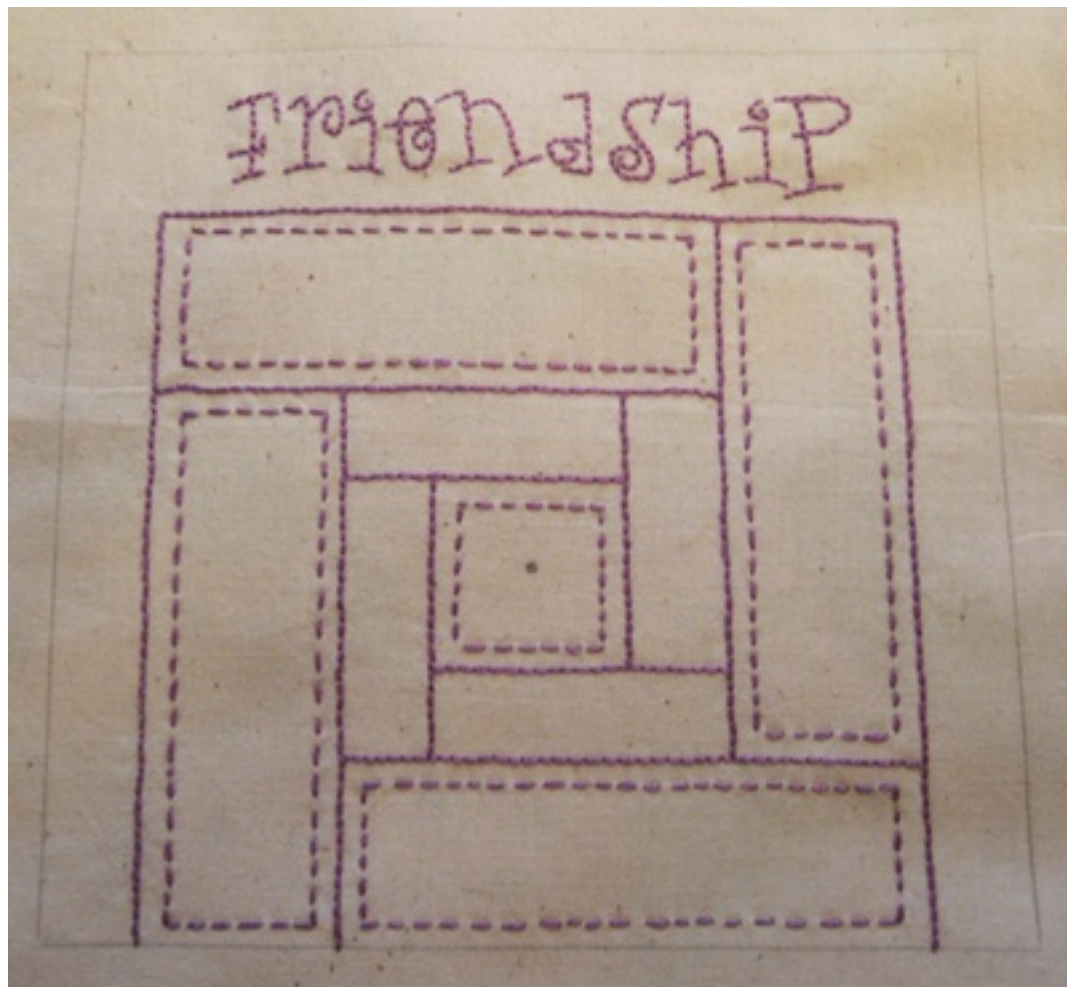

This first block of this quilt was released in honor of National Quilting Day in March 2010. It is a scrappy quilt. The quilter is supposed to choose her favorite color and find fabrics from her stash that contain that specific color. Blocks are to be 5" square when finished.

The inspiration quilt contains blocks with the following inspirations words: happiness, friendship, inspire, create, family, dream, peace, courage, love, hope, believe and faith. This quilt gives these snippets of advice to inspire each and every one of us in our daily lives and in our quest for creativity. All of these values are sooooo important in my life. I have concentrated on them throughout 2010.

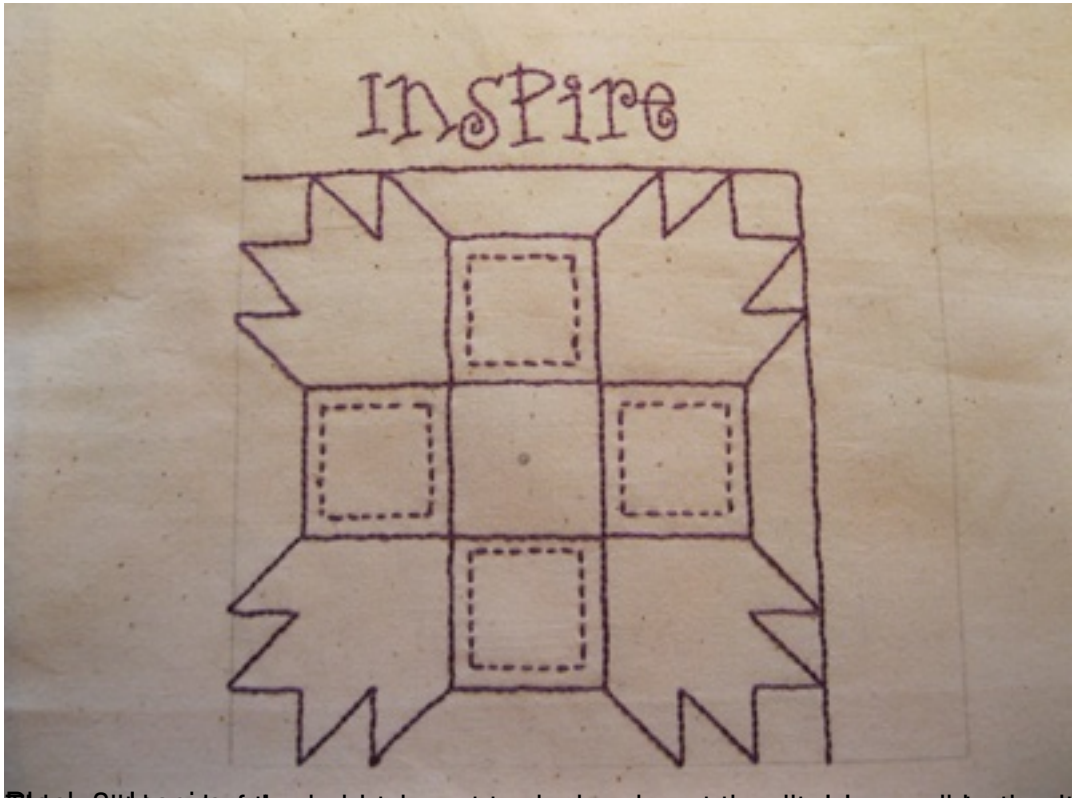
